He received his expertise degree on Biochemistry in 1979 at Cerrahpaşa Faculty of Medicine in Istanbul University. He worked as a researcher in Norway and in Germany (Max-Planck Institute) during these years, mostly on hormones. He co-founded Dr. Pakize Tarzi Laboratories in 1983. He received his PhD degree on Biochemistry from the Institute of Health Sciences, Marmara University in 2003. Since 1983, he has taught Biochemistry and Molecular Biology courses in several universities: Marmara University, Istanbul Technical University, Yeni Yüzyıl University, Okan University, SANKO University, Beykent University, Kemerburgaz University, and, now, Biruni University. He is currently a professor in the Faculty of Medicine in Biruni University. His expertise includes metabolism, metabolomics as well as bioentrepreneurship and biotechnology.
