About D Exams:

The D exam has entered into force and will be held in the Fall Semester of the 2024-2025 Academic Year on February 3-7, 2025.

Articles of the Regulation regarding the D exam:

ARTICLE 25– (1) Students who are required to attend classes are evaluated with an NA grade if they do not fulfill this obligation. In addition, students who have met the attendance requirement but have not fulfilled the obligations specified in the course information form are given a VF grade. Students who receive a VF or NA grade cannot take the end-of-term and D exams.

(3) Students who receive an FF grade from the course they took in the end-of-term exam are given a D exam at the time specified in the academic calendar for the semester they are registered for, and the result is announced as a letter grade. The grade received from the D exam determines whether the student's passing grade will be increased to DD, regardless of the student's success during the semester. If the student passes the D exam, they receive a DD grade. Students who do not take the exam or who do not perform well enough in the exam are given a grade of FF again. D exams are not held for courses such as internships, laboratories, projects and graduation projects. D exams are not evaluated within the scope of Article 29, and there is no make-up exam for D exams.

PS: Students who don't take the final exam cannot take D exam.
