<p>Students must register for the AERO491 - Graduation Project course opened on behalf of the Faculty Member by agreeing with a faculty member on the graduation project. (AERO492 – Graduation Project II course will continue with the same Faculty Member and subject.)</p> <p>Students must send an e-mail to our Department Secretary Bayram Sarı stating the title of the Project, CC the faculty member they have chosen to work with.</p>	Friday, October 4, 2024 at 17:00
<p>Students taking the AERO491 course will prepare a presentation explaining the purpose, scope, work steps, time plan and, if necessary, budget of the graduation project that will last two semesters and defend it in front of the jury assigned to them. The presentation duration will be a maximum of 10 minutes for each project. (AERO492 – Graduation Project II students will not make a pre-presentation.)</p>	Friday, November 1, 2024
<p>Students will prepare a Graduation Project I and/or II Report, which will describe the activities they have carried out during the semester, according to the current template announced on the department page and submit it in hard copy to the Department Secretariat. They will also send the reports to the jury members by e-mail. Students taking the AERO492 course must submit their reports in paperback.</p>	Monday, January 6, 2025 17:00
<p>Students who successfully complete the previous steps will make their Graduation Project I and II presentations in front of a jury of 3 assigned to them. The presentations will last a total of 20 minutes, including a 15-minute presentation and a 5-minute Q&A. Letter grades for AERO491 and AERO492 courses will be determined after the jury evaluation.</p>	Friday, January 17, 2025
