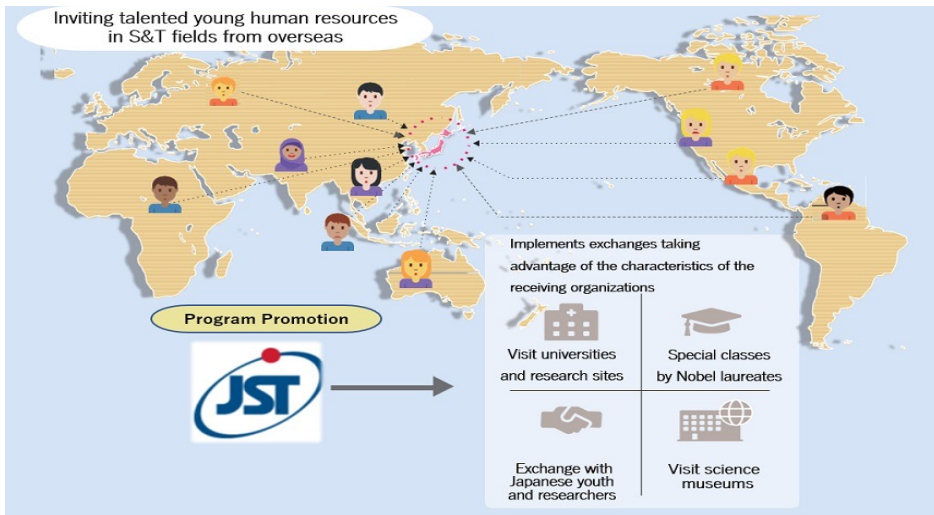




Sakura Science Exchange Program



CALL FOR STUDENTS TO JOIN SAKURA SCIENCE EXCHANGE PROGRAM AT KAGAWA UNIVERSITY, JAPAN

Kagawa University Institute of Education, Research and regional Cooperation for Crisis Management Shikoku (IECMS) makes a call to invite students from Gebze Technical University to join Sakura Science Exchange Program supported by Japan Science and Technology (JST). Since 2014, the program has invited talented young foreign human resources for short-term visits to Japan, giving them the opportunity to experience both Japan's cutting-edge science and technology and culture.
